Lac Seul is Developing a Land Code!

In 2019, Lac Seul became a signatory to the *Framework Agreement on First Nation Land Management*.

A Land Code:

- **Is created by a First Nation**
- **Replaces the land management sections of the Indian Act**
- **Removes the Government of Canada from reserve land management**



A Land Code can help:

- **Protect cultural heritage**
- **Provide more funding opportunities**
- **Support economic growth**
- **Enforce land laws on-reserve**



To develop a Land Code:

- **Land Code is developed by the membership**
- **Membership is involved in all parts of the development**
- **Membership votes on Land Code and Individual Agreement**

The most important piece to the Land Code development, is the Membership.
